FLU SEASON HAS STARTED!

The flu is caused by a virus and very contagious (spread easily) mainly by coughing, sneezing or close contact. Young children and older adults are at highest risk, but anyone can get it. Unlike a cold (virus), flu symptoms start suddenly. **They appear about 1-4 days after a person is exposed to the flu virus.** Please monitor your child for the following symptoms:

- Fever or feeling feverish and chills
- Cough, sore throat, runny nose or stuffy nose
- Muscle or body aches, headaches, tiredness
- Some children may have vomiting/or diarrhea



The flu can be passed to others from 1 day before you have symptoms up to 5-7 days after you get sick. Some might be able to infect others even longer.

KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME and notify or take them to the pediatrician for diagnosis and advice for treatment.



KCCS HEALTH POLICY states that your child must stay home until without a fever (temp not over 99.9) for a FULL 24 HOURS, without medication.

Please provide medical notes if the student is out more than 2 days.
