

HEALTH OFFICE MEDICAL NOTE TO KCCS PARENTS/GUARDIANS

MEDICATIONS

If your child is prescribed any medication to be taken during school hours (Inhalers, Epipens, or any medications, including over-the-counter meds, including cough drops), please provide the school with the medication and proper documentation from the doctor. Obtain the form, "<u>Parents and Physician's Authorization for Administration of</u> <u>Medication in school</u>", from the school nurse (your doctor may have a similar form). <u>Parents must complete part (B)</u> <u>and the doctor completes part (A).</u> Your doctor may also send an Asthma Action Plan or Allergy Action Plan. Return all forms to the nurse with the medication. <u>Parent/Guardian must bring the medication to the nurse</u>. <u>Students are not</u> <u>allowed to carry any meds</u>, <u>unless the doctor writes</u>, "The student may self-carry/self- administer". All completed forms can be faxed to the school # 716-895-2058. Absolutely NO medication will be allowed/or given in the school *unless this procedure is followed*.

PHYSICALS and IMMUNIZATIONS

NYS Public Health Law, Section 2164 requires that the parent/guardian provide the school with <u>an immunization record</u> or the student will not be permitted to attend/stay in school for 14 days or until proof of process, or the <u>immunizations are received/record provided</u>. Please provide the school with a recent official copy (from the health care provider, health department or a NYSIIS record). The school also requires a copy of a current physical. You may give us a copy or ask the <u>doctor's office to fax us a copy to # 716-895-2058</u>.

INJURIES, HOSPITALIZATIONS, CONTAGIOUS or PROLONGED ILLNESSES

Please provide the school with <u>medical documentation</u> stating the student can return to school and noting restrictions (if any) on the 'FIRST' day the student returns to school. A doctor's note is required to excuse any absences after 2 days. Students are NOT allowed to wear any type of injury equipment or items (ace wraps/bandages, slings, braces, boots, crutches, etc without a medical note to the nurse.
