A message from the
**SCHOOL
NURSE**



Parents please note these requirements when your child is ill or injured:

•If your child is ill (Flu, fever above 99.8, severe cold symptoms, vomiting, diarrhea, strep throat, breathing problems, unusual rashes or pains, etc) please **DO NOT** send them to school. Notify or take them to their doctor for advise/or prescribed care and medication. **The student should be without symptoms for a FULL 24 hours without medication before they return to school.**

•A parent note is required to excuse absences due to illnesses up to two days.

•If your child is ill and absent for **more than 2 days, the nurse will need a doctor's note to excuse the absences.**

•**ALL injuries require a doctor's note** stating the student can return to school and note any restrictions (if any), on **FIRST DAY** that the student returns or you will be called to pick up the student.

•At the discretion of the nurse, you may be asked to seek medical care and provide documentation for any questionable rash, illness or injury.
