From the Health Office

According to the CDC.....Washing your hands is easy, and it's one of the most effective ways to prevent the spread of germs. Studies have shown that handwashing can prevent lin 3 diarrhea-related sicknesses and lin 5 respiratory infections, such as a cold or the flu.

Follow these five easy steps every time:

#1. WET your hands with clean, running water (warm or cold), and apply soap.

#2. LATHER your hands by rubbing them together with the soap. Lather the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails.

#3. SCRUB your hands for at least 20 seconds. Need a timer? Hum the "Happy Birthday" song from beginning to end twice or just count to twenty seconds.

#4. RINSE your hands well under clean, running water.

#5. DRY your hands using a clean towel or air dry them.

If soap and water aren't available, you can use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol and scrub your hands until it is completely dry (about 20 seconds).
